LOCATION: King George V Playing Fields, Topsham Road,

Recommendation:

Although we have no in-principle objection to the above planning application at this stage, the applicant must submit additional information, as outlined below, in order to demonstrate that all aspects of the proposed surface water drainage management system have been considered.

Observations:

The applicant should assess above-ground surface water drainage features where possible.

Surface water drainage should be assessed for all impermeable areas or areas which will require drainage. This should include areas such as the paddle courts as well as the access road.

Surface water management for the car park within the northwest corner of the site should be considered and improved if possible.

The applicant should assess the condition and capacity of any watercourse or surface water drainage system within the site.

Maintenance responsibilities might need further consideration at this stage. It is understood that Exeter City Council might have some maintenance responsibilities for the current park. Will this responsibility continue if the proposals are built?
