

Existing Cob wall retained

Existing rubble stone walling and hedge retained and made good where required. Stone walling terminated with new ashlar stone gateway piers where new access formed to Pinhoe Road.

New ashlar stone gateway piers where new access is formed to Pinhoe Road. These are to be modelled on the existing piers to Pinhoe Road where pedestrian access connects to the top of Lamacraft Drive.

c1.8m high close boarded timber fence (with gates as required). Existing fence along the western boundary to be retained and repaired where required.

c2.0m high close boarded timber fence. This in part sits along side an existing wall which steps down the eastern boundary.

c.1.1m high metal decorative railings (with gates where required).


