Thank you for your consultation with attached HRA of 20th October. Doesn't give us much time to respond given the Harlequin proposal goes to Committee on Monday! However, Natural England concurs with the conclusion of your Appropriate Assessment but only if the HRA is precise in setting out the number of residential units to be granted permission under this proposal. Your Officer's Report details a developer contribution of £107,375 based on 26 cluster flats and 99 studios, which matches your current tariff of £859 per residential unit. However I can find no reference to that particular configuration in any of the documents submitted by the developer, the numbers of which have varied significantly during the progress of this application. This makes it even more important that your Members can be confident that they can be certain that no adverse effect on the integrity of the Exe Estuary SPA when determining the application on Monday.
